IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter eleven, section forty-nine of the revised statutes, in relation to the duties of superintending school committees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter eleven, section forty-nine of the revised stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by adding to the end of the
- 3 first specification the following words, "and at the
- 4 examination of all such persons a majority of the com-
- 5 mittee shall be present," so that said specification
- 6 shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 49. They shall appoint suitable times and
- 8 places for the examination of candidates who propose

9 to teach in town, and give notice thereof; and at the 10 examination of all such persons a majority of the com11 mittee shall be present.
