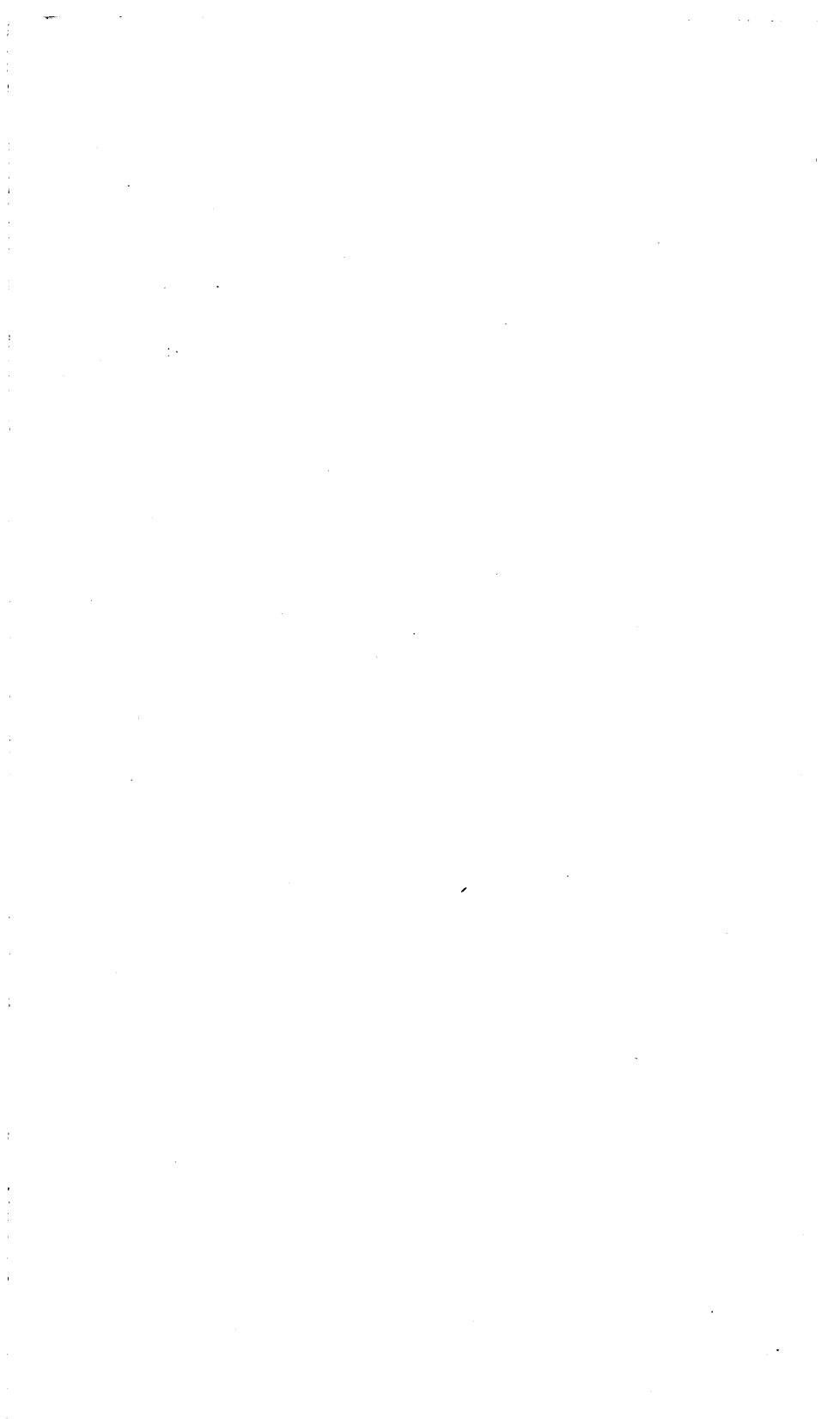

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the payment of lost bonds, coupons and
other state securities.

Resolved, That all claims for the payment of any
2 bond, coupon, scrip or other evidence of indebtedness
3 issued by the state, and which may have been de-
4 stroyed or lost, shall be referred to the governor and
5 council, who may, upon satisfactory proof of such
6 destruction or loss, cause payment of the same to be
7 made, upon the claimant filing with the state treasurer
8 a bond, with securities thereto, satisfactory to the said
9 governor and council.
