AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In order to provide for several acts and  
2 resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of  
3 money from the treasury, and also to provide for the  
4 necessary expenditures of government for the current  
5 fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated  
6 out of any moneys in the treasury, and the governor  
7 with the advice and consent of the council is hereby  
8 authorized at any time prior to the first day of Janu-  
9 ary next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury for  
10 the same :
