AMENDMENTS A AND B TO BILL AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER
ELEVEN OF SECTION FORTY-NINE OF THE REVISED STATUTES
IN RELATION TO THE DUTIES OF SUPERINTENDING SCHOOL
COMMITTEES.

A.

Insert after the word "present" in the fifth line, the
2 following words, "and they shall be entitled to receive
3 a sum not exceeding one dollar from each candidate
4 applying for examination at any other time than the
5 regular examinations."

B.

Add after eleventh line the same words, viz.: "and
2 they shall be entitled to receive a sum not exceeding
3 one dollar from each candidate applying for examina-
4 tion at any other time than the regular examinations."
