IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT permitting assessors of plantations organized for election purposes to establish a basis on which school money may be raised in such plantations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The assessors of plantations organized

- 2 for election purposes, are hereby authorized to take a
- 3 census of the inhabitants thereof, at the expense of
- 4 said plantation for the purpose of establishing a basis
- 5 for raising and expending school money according to
- 6 the provisions of section fifth of chapter eleven of the
- 7 revised statutes relating to education; and whenever
- 8 such a census shall have been so taken, the money
- 9 raised and expended in such plantation for the main-

- 10 tenance of schools shall be upon the basis of such 11 special census and not upon the census of the state.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
