IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

---

AN ACT permitting assessors of plantations organized for election purposes to establish a basis on which school money may be raised in such plantations.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The assessors of plantations organized  
2 for election purposes, are hereby authorized to take a  
3 census of the inhabitants thereof, at the expense of  
4 said plantation for the purpose of establishing a basis  
5 for raising and expending school money according to  
6 the provisions of section fifth of chapter eleven of the  
7 revised statutes relating to education ; and whenever  
8 such a census shall have been so taken, the money  
9 raised and expended in such plantation for the main-

10 tenance of schools shall be upon the basis of such  
11 special census and not upon the census of the state.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
