#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to make valid certain doings of the city government of the city of Bath, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The doings of the city council of the city of Bath, in

- 2 regard to raising by loan on the credit of the city, the
- 3 sum of six thousand dollars, appropriating the same to
- 4 the relief of the sufferers by the late fire in Portland,
- 5 and authorizing the mayor to draw his order on the
- 6 treasurer for, and remit the same to the mayor of
- 7 Portland; and also the action of the mayor in drawing
- 8 and remitting said sum of six thousand dollars to the
- 9 mayor of Portland; and all taxes assessed or hereafter

10 assessed to raise money for the above named purpose, 11 or to meet any pecuniary liability arising out of any 12 of the aforesaid doings, are hereby made valid in as 13 full and ample manner as though all the proceedings 14 had been previously authorized by law.
