RESOLVE providing for the appointment of a commissioner on industrial schools for girls.

Resolved, That the governor is hereby authorized to

- 2 appoint a commissioner, whose duty shall be to inves-
- 3 tigate the principles and operation of industrial schools
- 4 for girls, and report to the next legislature on the ex-
- 5 pediency of establishing such an institution in this
- · 6 state; and that there be appropriated out of the state
 - 7 treasury a sum not exceeding one hundred and twenty-
 - 8 five dollars in payment of the services of said com-
 - 9 missioner.

This resolve shall take effect on its approval by the 2 governor.
