
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-two of chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-two of chapter eleven of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended by inserting in the fourth
- 3 line, next after the word "dollar," the words, "and
- 4 fifty cents," so that said section as amended shall read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Sect. 52. Superintending school committees and
- 7 supervisors shall be paid for their services, on satisfy-
- 8 ing the municipal officers that they have made the
- 9 returns to the secretary of state required by law, one
- 10 dollar and fifty cents a day and all necessary travelling
- 11 expenses, and no more unless ordered by the town.
