STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the purchase of the Knox mansion.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding three thousand
2 dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated and
3 made subject to the governor's order for the purchase
4 and repair of the Knox mansion in the town of Thom-
5 aston, which purchase and repairs the governor, with
6 the advice of the council, is hereby authorized to
7 make; *provided* an equal sum shall be raised by the
8 citizens of Thomaston, and other towns in Knox coun-
9 ty, in aid of said purchase and repairs; *provided also*,
10 that the governor shall cause a thorough survey and
11 examination of said mansion and the premises, to de-
12 termine whether the condition thereof shall be such as
13 to render the purchase advisable.

Resolved, That the said mansion when purchased and
2 repaired, shall receive the name of “The Knox Memo-
3 rial Hall,” and shall be held by the state in honor of
4 General Knox, and also be consecrated to the memory
5 of the brave soldiers of Knox county who lost their
6 lives, for their country’s cause, in the late civil war.

Resolved, That the said Memorial Hall shall be appro-
2 priated to such uses as the governor and council shall
3 direct, subject to the action of the legislature.
