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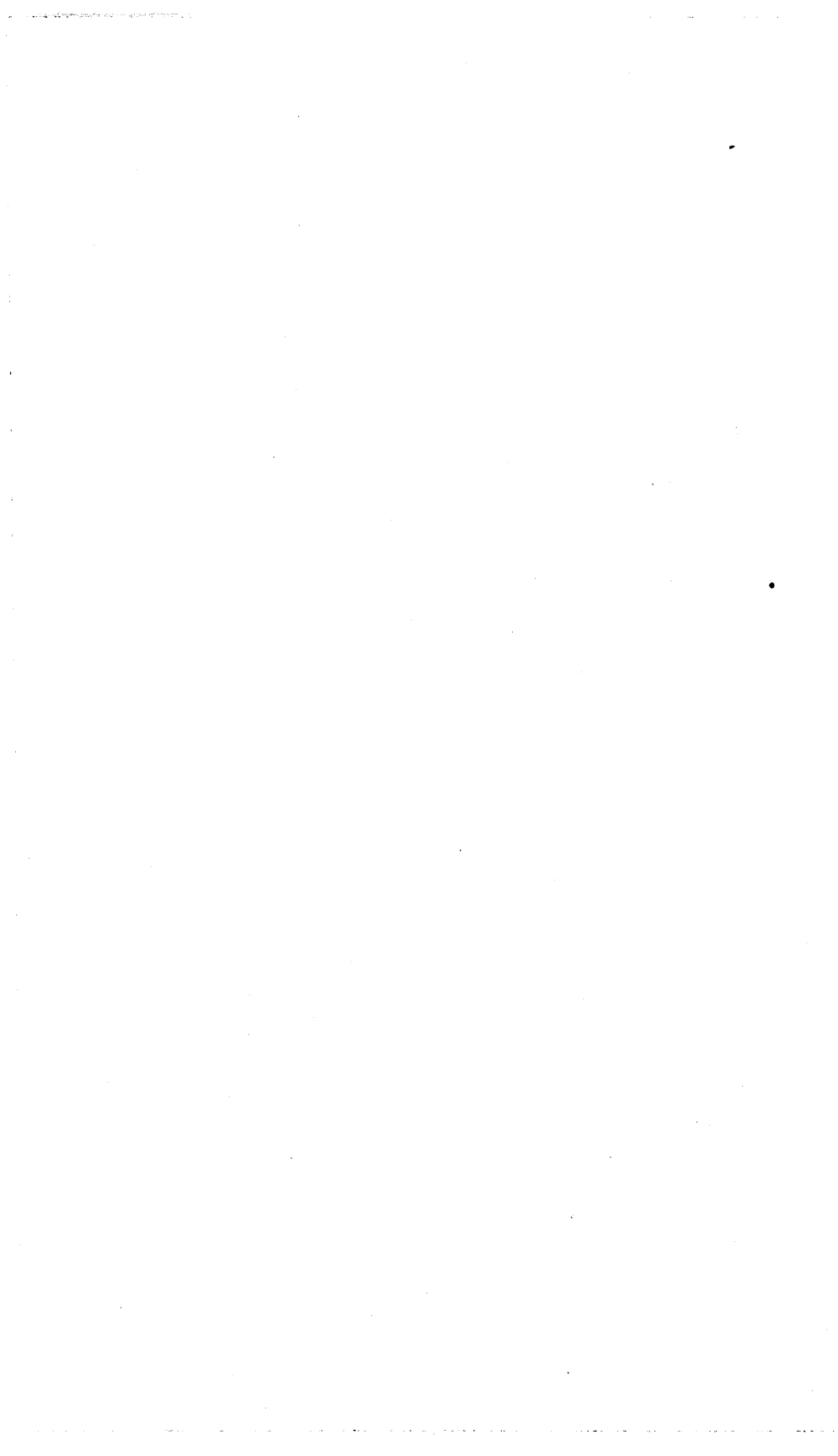
## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of Wales Hubbard.

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*Resolved,* That the claim of Wales Hubbard for balance of salary still remaining unpaid during the time he performed the duties of reporter of judicial decisions, and for the amount that should be paid him under the act approved April the fourth, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, be referred to the governor and council, who are hereby authorized to examine the same, and determine the amount he is entitled to, and the governor may draw his warrant for such amount, payable out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.
