RESOLVE in favor of Wales Hubbard.

Resolved, That the claim of Wales Hubbard for bal2 ance of salary still remaining unpaid during the time
3 he performed the duties of reporter of judicial deci4 sions, and for the amount that should be paid him
5 under the act approved April the fourth, in the year
6 one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, be referred
7 to the governor and council, who are hereby authorized
8 to examine the same, and determine the amount he is
9 entitled to, and the governor may draw his warrant for
10 such amount, payable out of any money in the state
11 treasury not otherwise appropriated.
