#### FORTY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty thousand dollars

- 2 (\$20,000) is hereby appropriated out of any money in
- 3 the treasury of the state not otherwise appropriated, for
- 4 the erection of two college buildings for the use of the
- 5 State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts,
- 6 and for the purchase of apparatus required by the
- 7 institution; to be expended under the direction of the
- 8 trustees of said college.
