SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL No. 17.

A.

Amend by adding at the end of the second section the following words :

“ When the three boards of selectmen, assessors and
2 overseers, or any two of them, are composed wholly of
3 the same men, there shall be but one designation of
4 the men so composing the boards, which designation
5 shall apply to all the boards so composed.”

B.

Amend by adding the following section :

SECT. 5. The secretary of state is hereby directed
2 to notify the town clerks of the several towns in this
3 state of the passage of this act, and notice shall be
4 given to towns in the warrant calling the first annual
5 town meeting after the passage of this act.
