IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section sixty-one of chapter eleven of the revised statutes of this state relating to raising money in plantations for building school houses and for school purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section sixty-one of chapter eleven of the revised

- 2 statutes is hereby amended, by striking out in the
- 3 fifth line of said section, after the word "not," the
- 4 words, "exclusive of," and inserting instead thereof
- 5 the word "including," so that the said section, as
- 6 amended, shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 61. Such districts, at meetings called for the
- 8 purpose, may raise money and choose committees to

9 hire, buy or build a school house for their use; and 10 the plantation assessors shall make a valuation of the 11 real and personal estate in the district, whether owned 12 by residents or not, including wild lands, and assess 13 the money so raised on the polls and estates, and com-14 mit the tax to the collector, who shall collect it and

15 pay it into the treasurer.
