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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT additional to an act to establish the State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No vacancy occurring in the board of  
2 trustees of the State College of Agriculture and the  
3 Mechanic Arts, shall hereafter be filled, until the num-  
4 ber of said trustees shall be less than seven ; and  
5 thereafterwards the number of said trustees shall be  
6 seven and no more.

SECT. 2. Whenever, during the year eighteen hun-  
2 dred sixty-seven, the number of said trustees shall be  
3 reduced below seven, by death, resignation or other-  
4 wise, the governor and council shall fill all vacancies  
5 so occurring, so that the number of said trustees shall

6 not be less than seven ; and the trustees so appointed  
7 shall hold said office for the term of seven years.

SECT. 3. After the year eighteen hundred and sixty-  
2 seven, all vacancies occurring in said board of trus-  
3 tees, shall be filled by said trustees, by ballot, a  
4 majority of the whole number being required for an  
5 election. And every trustee so elected shall hold said  
6 office for the term of seven years, and until the next  
7 regular session of the board after the expiration of  
8 said term.

SECT. 4. All parts of chapter five hundred thirty-  
2 two of the public laws of eighteen hundred sixty-five,  
3 inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed. And  
4 this act shall take effect from and after its approval by  
5 the governor.
