IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-six of chapter thirtyeight of the revised statutes relating to pressed hay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-six of chapter thirty-eight

- 2 of the revised statutes of this state is hereby amended
- 3 in the fourth line by inserting before the word
- 4 "weight" the word "net" so that said section as
- 5 amended shall read as follows:-" Every bale of
- 6 screwed or pressed hay may have four pieces of sea-
- 7 soned board not more than four inches wide or one
- 8 inch thick to keep the hay in place; one of which, or
- 9 on one of the bands, shall be marked the net weight

- 10 of the bale, and no sworn weigher of hay shall pur-
- 11 chase any hay but what is necessary for his own use."
 - Sect. 2. Before the words or figures denoting the
 - 2 weight of the bale the word "net" shall be written or
 - 3 branded.
