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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section thirty-six of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes relating to pressed hay.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-six of chapter thirty-eight  
2 of the revised statutes of this state is hereby amended  
3 in the fourth line by inserting before the word  
4 “weight” the word “net” so that said section as  
5 amended shall read as follows:—“Every bale of  
6 screwed or pressed hay may have four pieces of sea-  
7 soned board not more than four inches wide or one  
8 inch thick to keep the hay in place ; one of which, or  
9 on one of the bands, shall be marked the net weight

10 of the bale, and no sworn weigher of hay shall pur-  
11 chase any hay but what is necessary for his own use.”

SECT. 2. Before the words or figures denoting the  
2 weight of the bale the word “net” shall be written or  
3 branded.
