STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend “an act to establish the compensation of the clerk of the judicial courts for the county of Cumberland,” approved March twenty-ninth, eighteen hundred fifty-nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The first section of said act is hereby amended by
2 striking out in the third line thereof the words “fifteen
3 hundred dollars” and inserting instead thereof the
4 words “eighteen hundred dollars,” so that said sec-
5 tion shall read as follows :—Instead of the compensa-
6 tion now provided by law, the clerk of the judicial
7 courts for the county of Cumberland, shall receive a

8 yearly salary of eighteen hundred dollars, and shall be
9 allowed yearly in addition thereto the sum of one thou-
10 sand dollars for clerk hire ; said sums to be paid him
11 in quarterly payments out of the treasury of the county,
12 from and after the first day of April next ; said salary
13 and clerk hire shall be in full for all services and duties
14 required of him by law, including those performed by
15 him as clerk of the county commissioners, or by any
16 substitute appointed by them clerk *pro tempore* in ac-
17 cordance with the tenth section of the seventy-eighth
18 chapter of the revised statutes, and no other compen-
19 sation whatever shall be paid him out of the treasury
20 of the county.
