STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter eleven of the revised statutes, relating to building of school houses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. When in the opinion of the superintend-
- 2 ing school committee, any school district in their town
- 3 unreasonably neglects or refuses to raise money for
- 4 erecting, repairing, renting or purchasing a school
- 5 house or school houses and out-buildings, such as the
- 6 wants of the district require, or for purchasing or rent-
- 7 ing land for them to stand upon and for yards and
- 8 play grounds, the municipal officers, upon the written
- 9 application of the superintending school committee,

- 10 shall insert in their warrant for calling the next town
 11 meeting for town affairs, an article to see if the town
 12 will vote to raise money in such school district for the
 13 purposes above named. And any sum or sums of
 14 money so voted to be raised shall be assessed upon the
 15 polls and estates therein and collected and paid over
 16 as if originally raised by the district. And thereupon
 17 the municipal officers shall appoint three suitable in18 habitants of the town a committee to superintend the
 19 expenditure of the money for such purpose, and they
 20 shall have all the powers of a committee chosen by the
 - Sect. 2. In school districts not having a sufficient 2 number of legal voters to transact district business, 3 money may be raised and expended in the manner and

- 4 for the purposes specified in section first of this act.
- Sect. 3. In school districts not having a sufficient 2 number of legal voters to transact district business, 3 the superintending school committee of the town are 4 hereby empowered and required to perform the duties 5 imposed upon school agents by the second, third and 6 fifth specifications of section fifty-three chapter eleven
- SECT. 4. This act is not intended to repeal or affect 2 in any way section twenty-four of the chapter to 3 which it is additional.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its 2 approval.
