STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-six of chapter forty of revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The thirty-sixth section of chapter forty of revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the
3 fourth and fifth lines of said section the words “ one
4 half to the use of the county, and the other half to the
5 use of the town where the offence is committed,” and
6 inserting instead thereof the words “ to the use of the
7 prosecutor,” so that said section as amended shall
8 read as follows :

9 *Sect. 36.* All the penalties aforesaid, not exceeding
10 twenty dollars, shall be recovered by complaint before

11 a justice of the peace, and all exceeding that sum shall
12 be recovered by indictment, to the use of the prose-
13 cutor when not otherwise provided.
