STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to taxation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The first division of section eleven of 2 chapter six of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, 3 so as to read as follows: "All goods, wares and mer-4 chandise, all logs, timber, boards and other lumber, 5 and all stock in trade, including stock employed in 6 the business of any of the mechanic arts, in any town 7 within this state other than where the owners reside, 8 shall be taxed in such town, if the owners, their ten-9 ants, or any person contracting under them, for the

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10 building of any house, shop, store or vessel, occupy 11 any store, shop, mill, wharf or shipyard therein, for 12 the purposes of such tenancy or contract, and shall not 13 be taxable where the owner or owners reside.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
