AN ACT relating to constructing aqueducts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

With the written consent of the municipal officers of

- 2 a town, any person may within such town dig up and
- 3 open any street or way for the purpose of placing
- 4 pipes necessary in constructing an aqueduct in which
- 5 to convey pure water, or for repairing or extending it,
- 6 if it is done so as not to prevent the convenient pass-
- 7 ing of teams and carriages.
