STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to constructing aqueducts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

With the written consent of the municipal officers of
2 a town, any person may within such town dig up and
3 open any street or way for the purpose of placing
4 pipes necessary in constructing an aqueduct in which
5 to convey pure water, or for repairing or extending it,
6 if it is done so as not to prevent the convenient pass-
7 ing of teams and carriages.
