
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to evidence of the enlistment and situation of soldiers during their service under the United States government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The certificate of the adjutant general
- 2 of this state from the records of his office relating to
- 3 the enlistment of any person into the United States
- 4 service from this state, and of all facts pertaining to
- 5 the situation of such person up to and including his
- 6 discharge, as found upon the records in said office,
- 7 shall be prima facie evidence of the facts so found
- 8 upon the records and certified to in any suit or pro-
- 9 ceeding in any of the courts and tribunals of this state.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
