## STATE 0F MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT IUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and thirty-six of chapter six of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one hundred and thirty-six of chapter six of 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out 3 the word " his" between " of" and "county" in sec4 ond line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "any," 5 so that said section when amended shall read as fol6 lows:

7 Sect. 130. The treasurer of any torm, who is also 8 collector, may issue his warrant to the sheriff of any 9 county, or to his deputy, or a constable of his town, 10 directing him to distrain the person or property of any

[^0]11 person who is delinquent in paying his taxes, after the 12 expiration of the time fixed for payment, by vote of 13 the town; which warrant shall be of the same tenor 14 as that prescribed to be issued by municipal officers or 15 assessors to collectors, changing such parts as ought to 16 be changed, returnable to the treasurer in thirty days.
