#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES relating to the documentary history of Maine.

WHEREAS, the Maine Historical Society proposes to

- 2 publish annually a volume in a series of volumes con-
- 3 taining the earliest documents, charters and other state
- 4 papers illustrating the history of Maine, and
- 5 Whereas, the funds of the society, derivable from
- 6 its annual income, are insufficient for this purpose, and
- 7 Whereas, other states have, at great expense, pro-
- 8 cured and published their documentary history at the
- 9 public expense, therefore

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby

- 2 authorized to enter into contract with the Maine His-
- 3 torical Society to afford encouragement in aid of such
- 4 publication, and to subscribe for or cause to be pub-
- 5 lished in concurrence with said society, the same num-

6 ber of copies as of the annual volume of acts and 7 resolves, (not, however, to exceed one thousand copies 8 in all,) and to be distributed in the same manner; the 9 said volumes to be properly edited, with suitable notes 10 by said society, without expense to the state; provided 11 that the whole number of volumes annually printed 12 and distributed for the use of the state, shall not ex13 ceed the price of two dollars per volume, of not less 14 than five hundred pages each, with suitable indexes 15 and proper bindings.

Resolved, That all copies not required for distribution 2 in compliance with existing laws, as provided in this 3 resolve, shall be deposited for safe keeping in the 4 state library, and subject to the future disposition of 5 the legislature.
