
AN ACT to amend section one hundred and five of chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes relating to proceedings in court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one hundred and five of chapter
- 2 'eighty-two of the revised statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by adding thereto at its close the following words:
- 4 "and in case proceedings in any action shall be stayed
- 5 as provided in this section the defendant shall have,
- 6 and may maintain an action on the case against the
- 7 assignee for his costs up to the time when proceedings
- 8 are so stayed."
  - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
