STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to aid in the repair of certain roads and bridges
in this state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

That there be and hereby are appropriated, from any
2 moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
3 following sums, for which the governor may draw his
4 warrants on the treasurer, and which shall be expended
5 by agents appointed by the governor, by and with the
6 advice and consent of the council :

7 To aid in rebuilding the bridge over Wild river in
8 the town of Gilead and county of Oxford, three thou-
9 sand dollars.

10 For the repair of the road leading from Bethel to

11 Umbagog lake in the town of Grafton in the county of
12 Oxford, the sum of one thousand dollars.

13 For the repair of the road leading from Monson vil-
14 lage to Greenville in the county of Piscataquis, the
15 sum of fifteen hundred dollars ; five hundred dollars to
16 be expended in each of the towns of Monson, Shirley
17 and Greenville, whenever either of said towns shall
18 have first raised and expended a like sum of five hun-
19 dred dollars for the repair of said road within the lim-
20 its of said town, or such amounts have been raised and
21 expended in the several towns for such repair of said
22 road by individuals or by the combined contributions
23 of individuals and said towns.

24 Also, for the repair of the Canada road, so called,
25 and the bridges on the same, which road extends
26 from the north line of Moscow in the county of Som-
27 erset to the Canada line, the sum of two thousand
28 dollars.
