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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to revive an act entitled an act to incorporate the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railway Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-one of 2 the special laws approved March thirty-one eighteen 3 hundred and fifty-three, be and the same is hereby 4 revived, so that a further time of one year is allowed 5 from the approval of this act by the governor, in which 6 to organize said company and locate the line of its 7 road from tide waters at Belfast to the line of the 8 Maine Central Railroad Company, and a further time 9 of one year thereafter to complete the same ; and all

10 parts of said act inconsistent herewith are hereby  
11 repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved  
2 by the governor.
