STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to revive an act entitled an act to incorporate the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-one of

- 2 the special laws approved March thirty-one eighteen
- 3 hundred and fifty-three, be and the same is hereby
- 4 revived, so that a further time of one year is allowed
- 5 from the approval of this act by the governor, in which
- 6 to organize said company and locate the line of its
- 7 road from tide waters at Belfast to the line of the
- 8 Maine Central Railroad Company, and a further time
- 9 of one year thereafter to complete the same; and all

- 10 parts of said act inconsistent herewith are hereby 11 repealed.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
