#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighteen of the revised statutes relating to ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The municipal officers of a town may
- 2 lay out a way as provided in section eighteen of chap-
- 3 ter eighteen of the revised statutes, for the purposes
- 4 of hauling wood or lumber, and to be used only when
- 5 the ground is so covered with snow that such hauling
- 6 shall not in any way tear up or break the soil under-
- 7 neath such way.
  - Sect. 2. When so laid out, such municipal officers
- 2 shall state in their return the purposes for which such
- 3 road is laid, and that the same shall be used only dur-

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- 4 ing the winter season, and shall in their return order
- 5 the person or persons for whose accommodation such
- 6 road is laid out to pay into the town treasury wherein
- 7 such road is located an amount equal to the damages
- 8 and expenses of such location, for the benefit of the
- 9 owner of the land over which such way is laid, and
- 10 such road shall not be accepted by the town until such
- 11 amount is so paid.
  - Sect. 3. No town shall be liable for any damage to
  - 2 any person travelling or in any way going upon such
  - 3 way.

Sect. 4. This act to take effect when approved by 3 the governor.
