STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of fish in the Damariscotta river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. No person shall be allowed during the 2 months of December, January, February and March 3 of each year, to take fish by the use of nets or seines 4 from the Damariscotta river and its tributaries, so far 5 up said river as the tide waters extend.

SECT. 2. If any person shall take fish from said 2 river or its tributaries in violation of the provisions of 3 this act, he shall forfeit and pay a penalty of fifty 4 dollars for each offence; one half to the use of the

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5 state, and the other half to the use of the person 6 prosecuting therefor.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force 2 from and after its approval by the governor.
