STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to judicial proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. In bills in equity and libels for divorce
- 2 inserted in writs of attachment, the law authorizing
- 3 the same shall not be construed to require the signa-
- 4 ture of the complainant or libellant either in cases
- 5 already decided, now pending or hereafter to be com-
- 6 menced.
- SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the governor.
