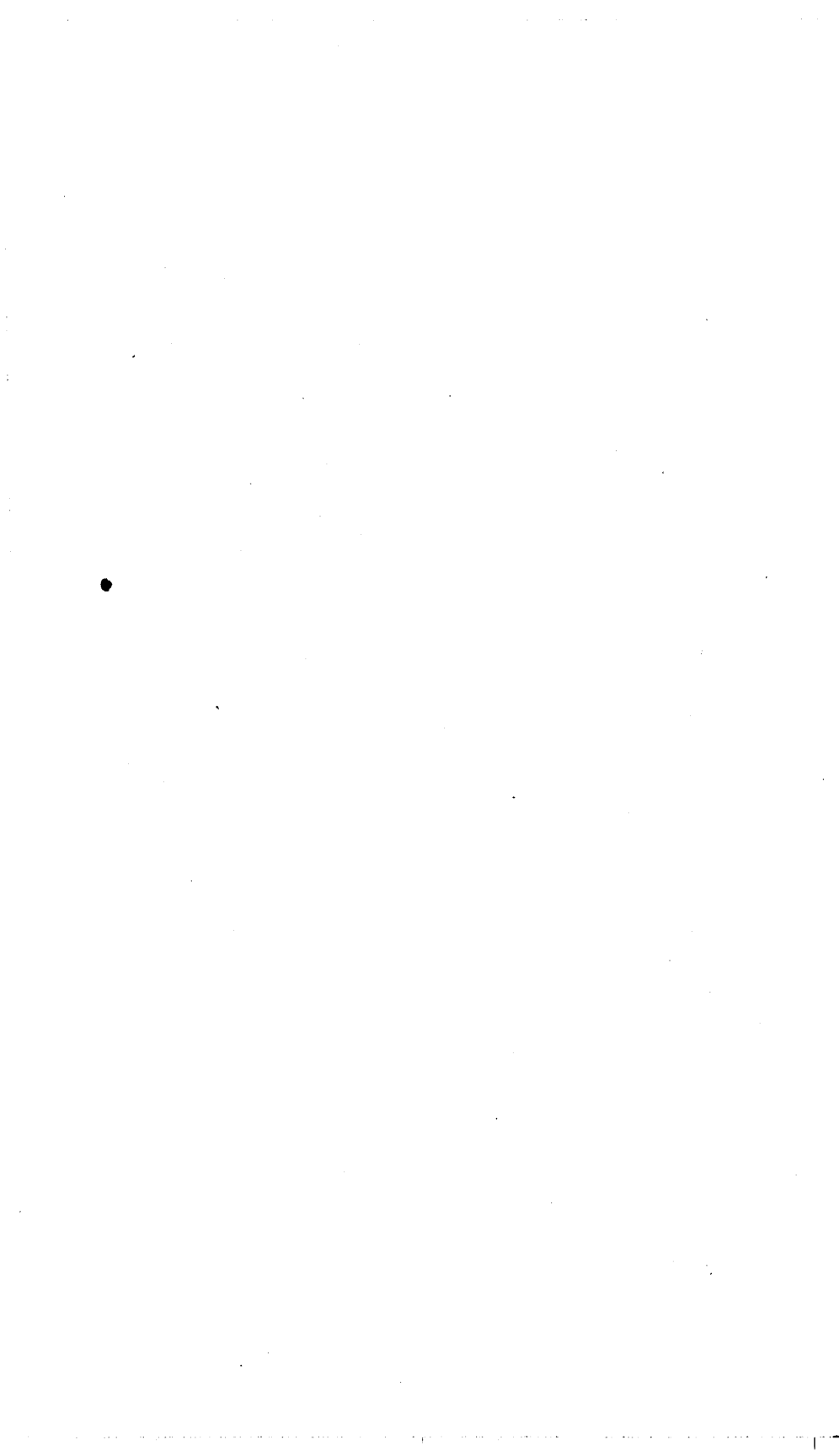
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED **AND**
SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to judicial proceedings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In bills in equity and libels for divorce
2 inserted in writs of attachment, the law authorizing
3 the same shall not be construed to require the signa-
4 ture of the complainant or libellant either in cases
5 already decided, now pending or hereafter to be com-
6 menced.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its approval by the governor.
