IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-nine, section seven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter twenty-nine of
- 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 in the third and fourth lines all after the word "after"
- 4 and inserting the words "ten o'clock in the afternoon
- 5 of any day," so that said section when amended shall
- 6 read as follows:
 - SECT. 7. The keeper of any billiard room or table,
- 2 who admits minors thereto without the written consent
- 3 of their parent or guardian, or suffers any persons to
- 4 play there after ten o'clock in the afternoon of any

- 5 day, shall forfeit ten dollars for the first, and twenty
- 6 for each subsequent offence.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
