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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-nine, section seven of the revised statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter twenty-nine of  
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out  
3 in the third and fourth lines all after the word "after"  
4 and inserting the words "ten o'clock in the afternoon  
5 of any day," so that said section when amended shall  
6 read as follows :

SECT. 7. The keeper of any billiard room or table,  
2 who admits minors thereto without the written consent  
3 of their parent or guardian, or suffers any persons to  
4 play there after ten o'clock in the afternoon of any

5 day, shall forfeit ten dollars for the first, and twenty  
6 for each subsequent offence.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved  
2 by the governor.
