STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Leeds and Farmington Railroad Company to make a lease and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The Leeds and Farmington Railroad Company is hereby authorized and empowered to make a lease of its railroad extending from Leeds crossing to Farmington, with all its rolling stock, tools and other tangible personal property appurtenant thereto, with the franchise of said company, to the Androscoggin Railroad Company for a term of years.

SECT. 2. The Leeds and Farmington Railroad Company is hereby authorized to sell and convey its said railroad, with all its rolling stock, tools and other

4 tangible personal property, appurtenant thereto, with
5 the franchise of said corporation, to the Androscoggin
6 Railroad Company ; *provided* that the directors of said
7 company shall have no power to make such sale unless
8 authorized to do so by a vote of the stockholders in a
9 meeting legally called for that purpose, but such sale
10 shall not impair any rights or take away or diminish
11 any remedies of the creditors of either of said cor-
12 porations.
