STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter twenty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter twenty-four of 2 the public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight is 3 hereby amended by adding thereto the following words, 4 viz: Provided however, that the court, at any time, on 5 the petition of one or more persons having claims 6 against the bank, for good cause shown, may allow such 7 persons a further reasonable time after the expiration 8 of said six months to prove their claims before the 9 receivers, which, if allowed, are to be entitled to an 10 equal dividend with claims previously allowed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its 2 approval.
