### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

### AN ACT in relation to interest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Interest shall remain as heretofore at six per centum,

- 2 but parties to written contracts are authorized to fix
- 3 and determine the rate of interest on the same, not,
- 4 however, exceeding eight per centum.
