STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter six of the revised statutes,
in relation to the collection of taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Every collector, or constable, or other
2 person required to collect state, county or town taxes,
3 in cities and towns containing more than twenty-five
4 hundred inhabitants according to the next preceding
5 United States census, shall collect interest on taxes
6 remaining unpaid at the expiration of four months
7 from the time of the commitment. The interest is to
8 commence at said expiration.

SECT. 2. The mayor, aldermen and council of cities,
2 and towns at their annual town meetings, may in any

3 year by vote suspend the operation of this act so far
4 as relates to the collection of taxes assessed in such
5 city or town during the year ensuing.

SECT. 3. This act shall not apply to taxes already
2 assessed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect on its approval.
