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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend chapter ninety-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, relating to the annual distribution of school blanks.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter ninety-two of the  
2 public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, shall  
3 be amended by striking out the words “superintending  
4 school committee” and inserting in their stead the  
5 word clerk, and by adding thereto the words following:  
6 “And said clerk shall forthwith deliver the same to  
7 the superintending school committee of his respective  
8 city, town and plantation ;” so that the section as  
9 amended shall read :

*Sect. 1.* The secretary of state, shall, on the first  
2 day of March, in each year, forward to the clerk of  
3 the several cities, towns and plantations, blanks for  
4 the annual school return, and registers for the school  
5 year commencing on the first day of April following ;  
6 and said clerk shall forthwith deliver the same to the  
7 superintending school committee of his respective city,  
8 town and plantation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
