#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to an act to incorporate the Penobscot Mill Dam Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The last proviso of the second section
- 2 of an act to incorporate the Penobscot Mill Dam Com-
- 3 pany, approved the twelfth day of February, eighteen
- 4 hundred twenty-eight, is hereby repealed.
  - Sect. 2. The city of Bangor and the town of Brewer
- 2 are authorized to exempt from taxation, for any period
- 3 not extending beyond January first, eighteen hundred
- 4 and eighty-one, any or all improvements that may be
- 5 made in connection with the water power proposed to
- 6 be improved by said company; provided that no prop-

- 7 erty now in existence shall be so exempted from taxa-
- 8 tion; and provided further, that all such improvements
- $9\,$  shall be duly returned by the assessors for purposes of
- 10 state valuation.
