STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT extending the time within which certain banks shall redeem their bills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In all cases where the liability of any
2 bank in this state, to redeem its bills was extended by
3 chapter twenty-four, section first of the public laws of
4 eighteen hundred sixty-six, until the first of March,
5 eighteen hundred sixty-seven ; and in all cases where
6 the liability of any bank in this state, to redeem its
7 bills would expire after the passage of this act, and
8 previous to March first, eighteen hundred sixty-eight,
9 such liability shall be extended until the first day of

10 March, eighteen hundred sixty-eight, except such
11 banks as are now in the hands of receivers.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
