STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to the claims of the State of Maine against the United States for expenses incurred in the late rebellion.

Resolved, That the governor and council be and they 2 are hereby authorized to settle the accounts of the 3 agent charged by the executive with prosecuting the 4 claims of the state against the government of the 5 United States for expenses incurred in the late rebel- 6 lion, allowing their reasonable expenses and a just 7 compensation for services rendered, but no charge of 8 commissions for sums obtained of the general govern- 9 ment for the state shall be allowed, and the governor 10 with the advice of the council shall draw his warrant 11 upon the treasurer of the state therefor.
