STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to accept the surrender of the charter of the
Piscataqua Fire and Marine Insurance Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The surrender of the charter of the Pis-
cataqua Fire and Marine Insurance Company is hereby
accepted ; and its affairs shall be wound up in the
manner provided in sections nineteen and twenty of
chapter forty-six of the revised statutes ; *provided that*
so much of said acts as confer any special remedies
against officers or stockholders of said corporation shall
not be affected thereby ; nor shall this act relieve them
or any of them from any personal liabilities under any
of said acts, or under any of the statutes of this state,

11 or prevent any creditor from pursuing any remedies
12 conferred by chapter one hundred and thirteen of the
13 revised statutes.

SECT. 2. Actions pending against said company,
2 when trustees are appointed as provided in said sec-
3 tions, may be discontinued without payment of costs,
4 or continued, tried and judgment rendered, as in other
5 cases; actions may be also maintained upon claims
6 disallowed in whole or in part by the trustees; all
7 judgments shall be satisfied in the same manner as
8 other claims against the company are satisfied by the
9 trustees.

SECT. 3. This act takes effect when approved.
