IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-seven, section six of the revised statutes relating to tolls for grinding, cleansing and bolting grain.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The sixth section of chapter fifty-seven of the revised 2 statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word 3 grain in the second line of said section, the words 4 Buck wheat and Indian wheat. And by adding thereto 5 in the second line of said section after the word thereof, 6 the following: and for hulling, grinding and bolting 7 Buck wheat and Indian wheat, the toll shall not ex-8 ceed three quarts per bushel; and for grinding Buck 9 wheat and Indian wheat without hulling and bolting,

10 the toll shall be two quarts per bushel. So that the 11 section as amended shall read as follows :—The toll 12 for grinding, cleansing and bolting all kinds of grain 13 except Buck wheat and Indian wheat shall not exceed 14 one sixteenth part thereof; and for hulling, grinding 15 and bolting Buck wheat and Indian wheat, the toll 16 shall not exceed three quarts per bushel; and for 17 grinding Buck wheat and Indian wheat without hull-18 ing and bolting, the toll shall be two quarts per bushel.
