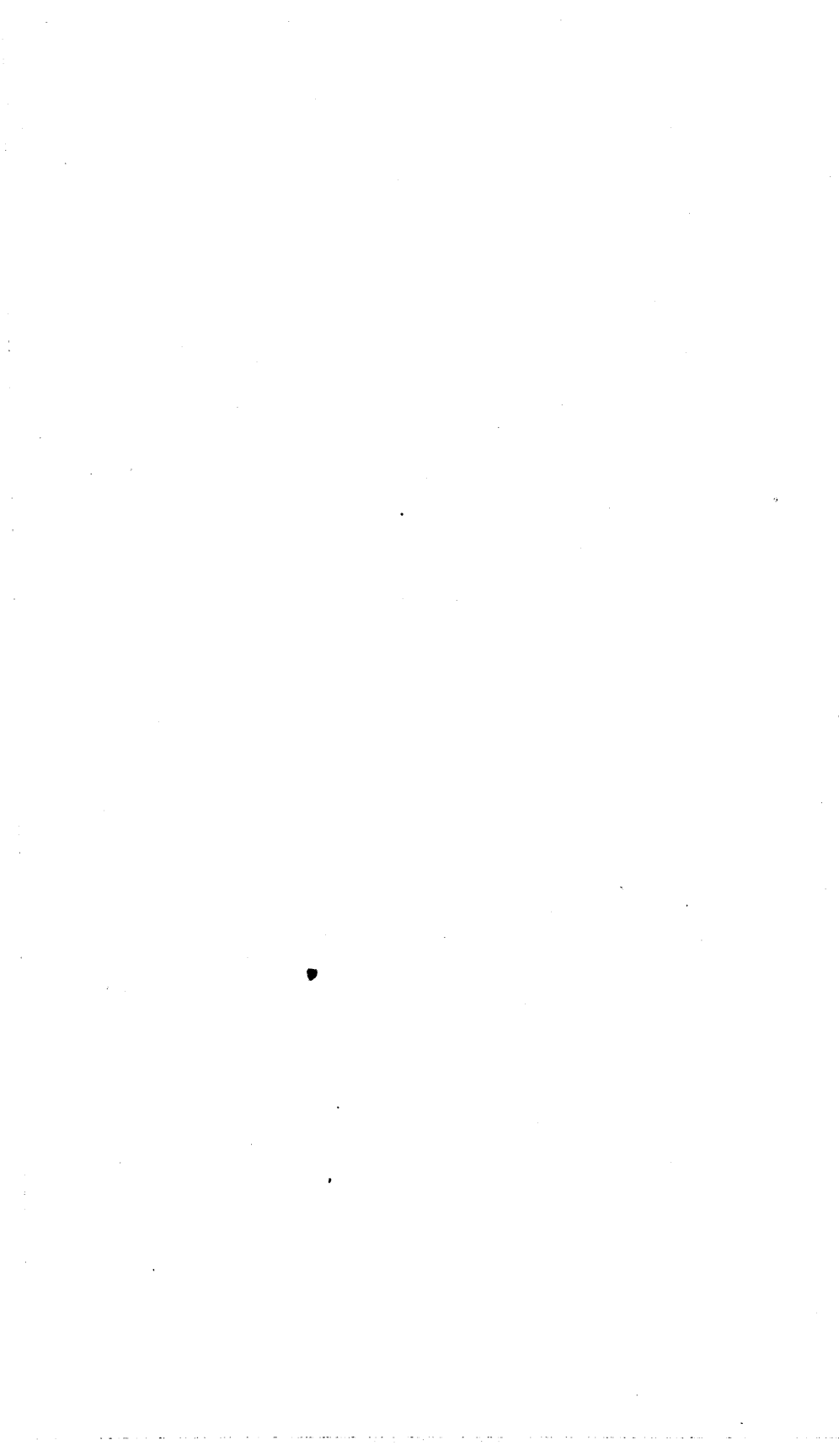

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of procuring a suitable portrait of Abraham Lincoln, late president of the United States:

Resolved, That the governor shall select and appoint 2 a suitable artist, who shall execute a portrait of Abra- 3 ham Lincoln, late president of the United States, un- 4 der such directions as the governor may make. And 5 the same portrait shall be placed in a conspicuous place 6 in the state house ; *provided* that the cost of said por- 7 trait does not exceed one thousand dollars, and the 8 governor and council are hereby instructed and author- 9 ized to draw their warrant for the amount that may 10 be necessary to complete said portrait, not exceeding 11 said amount.
