STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to set off a part of the town of Frankfort and annex the same to the town of Winterport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. All that part of Frankfort lying north-
- 2 easterly of a line beginning on the Penobscot river at
- 3 Abijah W. Hardy's south-west line, thence by said
- 4 line to the county road, thence across said road in a
- 5 straight course to Marsh stream at its nearest point,
- 6 and thence by said stream to Winterport line, is here-
- 7 by set off from said Frankfort and annexed to said
- 8 Winterport.
 - SECT. 2. One hundred forty-one polls, and one hun-
- 2 dred twenty-four thousand one hundred forty-nine dol-

- 3 lars are hereby taken from the polls and valuation of
- 4 said Frankfort and the same are added to the polls and
- 5 valuation of said Winterport; and state and county
- 6 taxes are hereafter to be assessed according to the
- 7 number of polls and valuation of said towns as hereby
- 8 fixed, until a new state valuation shall be established.
 - Sect. 3. Said territory and the inhabitants thereon,
- 2 with estates, shall pay their just proportion of the
- 3 present indebtedness of Frankfort over its assets, ac-
- 4 cording to the valuation thereof for eighteen hundred
- 5 sixty-six, and shall also pay five thousand dollars
- 6 additional, and shall not be entitled to a share in any
- 7 money that may be paid by the state or United States
- 8 to said town on account of raising men for the late war,
- 9 but all such money shall belong exclusively to said
- 10 town. The sums aforesaid shall be assessed by the
- 11 assessors of Frankfort upon the valuation of said polls
- 12 and estates made by the assessors of Winterport each
- 13 year, in annual assessments not exceeding twenty-five
- 14 hundred dollars till paid, and the same shall be col-
- 15 lected by the collector of Frankfort from time to time,
- 16 the same as if this act had not passed.
 - Sect. 4. Theodore C. Woodman, of Bucksport, is
 - 2 hereby appointed a commissioner to determine the lia-
 - 3 bilities and assets of said town of Frankfort within

- 4 sixty days after the passage of this act, after due no-
- 5 tice to each party and a hearing, and shall make to
- 6 each town a written report of the certain liabilities
- 7 and assets in dollars and cents, also the number and
- 8 nature of the liabilities and assets the precise amount of
- 9 which cannot be determined, and the proportion which
- 10 the territory and inhabitants hereby set off shall pay
- 11 when determined as provided in the preceding section.
 - Sect. 5. No part of the present indebtedness of
 - 2 Winterport shall be assessed upon said territory and
 - 3 inhabitants, except for the town farm, stock, tools, and
 - 4 housekeeping articles thereon.
 - Sect. 6. The town of Winterport shall support all
 - 2 paupers whose legal settlement is upon said territory.
 - Sect. 7. The town-house and lot and town pound
 - 2 and lot of said Frankfort shall be appraised by the
 - 3 commissioner aforesaid, and the value thereof shall
 - 4 be added to said territory's proportion of the indebt-
 - 5 edness of said Frankfort, and said property shall be-
 - 7 long to the inhabitants of said territory and may be
 - 8 disposed of by them as a majority may direct at meet-
 - 9 ings called by a justice of the peace on application of
- 10 ten of said inhabitants, and notice of such meetings
- 11 shall be posted in two public and conspicuous places
- 12 on said territory seven days at least prior thereto. But

- 13 the town safe and all other town property, not herein-
- 14 before mentioned shall remain the property of said
- 15 Frankfort.
 - Sect. 8. All uncollected taxes legally assessed on
 - 2 the inhabitants and estates herein set off shall be col-
 - 3 lected by the present collector of said Frankfort or his
 - 4 successor, and he shall be held to collect, pay over
 - 5 and account for them the same as if this act had not
 - 6 passed; and he is authorized to finish the collection
 - 7 of all taxes legally assessed on other parts of said
 - 8 town, and shall account to said town for all money in
 - 9 his hands or that may hereafter come into his hands as
- 10 collector or treasurer of said town, notwithstanding
- 11 that by this act his residence will be in the town of
- 12 Winterport.

Sect. 9. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
