STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Knox Agricultural and
Horticultural Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. N. A. Farwell, C. W. Snow, John P.

- 7 ham and Wm. Wilson, their associates, successors and
- 8 assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation
- 9 by the name of the Knox Agricultural and Horticul-
- 10 tural Society, with power by that name to sue and be

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- 11 sued; to have and use a common seal; to make by-
- 12 laws and all necessary regulations for the management
- 13 of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this
- 14 state; and to have all the rights and privileges, and
- 15 be subject to all the liabilities of similar societies in
- 16 this state.
 - Sect. 2. Said society is hereby established within
 - 2 the towns which comprise the county of Knox, and
 - 3 may take and hold real estate at a cost of five thou-
 - 4 sand dollars, (including grounds for fairs and race-
 - 5 course,) and personal property to the amount of five
 - 6 thousand dollars.
 - Sect. 3. The first meeting of said corporation may
 - 2 be called by any three of the persons named in the
 - 3 first section of this act, by giving such notice of the
 - 4 time, place and objects thereof, as they think proper;
 - 5 and at said meeting, the officers of said corporation
 - 6 may be chosen, and such other corporative business
 - 7 done as may be deemed proper.
 - SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
